BREAD FOR THE WORLD
Letter Writing Sunday, April 26

Question: Why do we need child nutrition programs? What aren't parents feeding them?

Answer: Many children live in working-poor families in which parents do not earn enough to pay for everything their family needs – rent, utilities, transportation, even food. Other parents cannot work for a variety of reasons, including disability or inability to find a job.

Question: Why do we need federal nutrition programs?

Answer: National nutrition programs allow many parents to work full days while children are away from home. National programs assure that children will receive nutritious meals under the same guidelines and funding in *each* state, even though the program is facilitated by the state in which the child lives.
